Pursuant to Elections Code Section 15101(a) the <u>Pre-Election Processing of Vote by Mail</u> ballot return envelopes (verification of signature and address and updating voter records) may begin 29 days before the election, and thus will commence as early as 8:00 a.m. during the weekday, starting on Wednesday February 19, 2025, at the City Hall, Council Chamber. Vote-by-mail ballot return envelopes processing may occur daily thereafter between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. It is anticipated that processing will occur at 9:00 a.m., however, based on demand and other City Clerk-related functions, the time may change. To determine if ballot processing will take place on a particular day/time, please call (562) 916-1248.

Pursuant to Elections Code Section 15101(b) the <u>Pre-Election Canvassing of vote-by-mail</u> and in-person ballots (opening the returned vote-by-mail ballot envelopes, removing the ballots, accurately duplicating any damaged or defective ballots, scanning, resolving ballots and preparing the ballots for the ballot count, including processing write-in votes so that they can be tallied by the machine) may begin up to 29 days before the election, and thus will commence at 8:00 am during the week starting on Wednesday, February 19, 2025, at the City Hall, Council Chamber. Vote-by-mail ballot return envelope and Provisional ballot envelope processing may occur daily thereafter between 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. To determine if ballot envelope processing will take place on a particular day, please call (562) 916-1248.
